The Perris Union High School District educates secondary (10,000 ADA) and adult students living in the Perris Valley, a 184 square mile blend of rural, suburban, and commercial neighborhoods in Riverside County.

Our students come from the surrounding districts of Perris Elementary (K-6), Romoland Elementary (K-8), Menifee Union Elementary (K-8), and Nuview Union Elementary (K-8). The district operates seven schools: one middle school (Pinacate, gr. 7-8), three comprehensive high schools (Heritage, Perris, Paloma Valley) one continuation high school (Perris Lake), one alternative school (The Academy), and two charter schools: Choice 2000 and the California Military Institute.

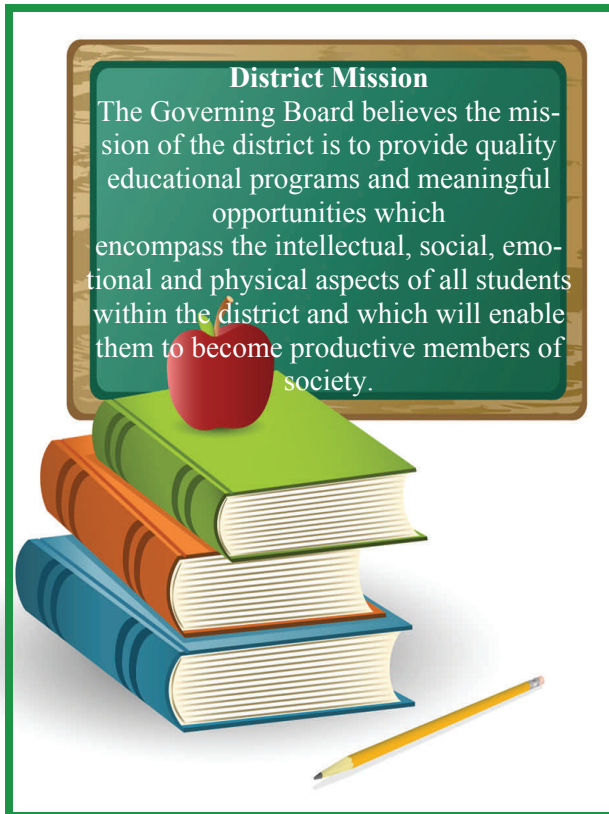
