- * Final judges: **Frederick Barthelme** (fiction) and **Julia Johnson** (poetry).
- * Current and former friends and students of the judges are not eligible to compete, nor are affiliates of the Center for Writers at the University of Southern Mississippi.
- * Fiction: send one story per entry. There is no length requirement.
- * Poetry: send up to five poems (no more than ten pages total) per entry.
- * Submissions must be previously unpublished.
- * Fee is \$10 per entry, by cash or check or money order, payable to *Juked*; there is no limit on the number of entries you may submit.
- * Include a cover sheet with your name, address, e-mail, telephone number and the title(s) of your story or poems. Please do not put your name anywhere else on the manuscript.
- * Include a SASE for notification.
- * Manuscripts will not be returned; instead they will be gently placed in the recycling bin.
- * Postmark deadline is August 31st, 2007.
- * Indicate "Fiction" or "Poetry" on the front of the envelope.
- * All entries will be considered for publication in *Juked* #5.
- * Results will be announced in October 2007.
