Reza Aslan Assistant Professor of Creative Writing Hajj: The Pilgrimage

The Hajj is a pilgrimage to Mecca. It's the largest annual pilgrimage in the world. It's the fifth pillar of Islam and an obligation that must be carried out at least once in the lifetime of every ablebodied Muslim who can afford to do so.

At a time when the health of the world may rely on bridging the divide between the U.S. and the Middle East, Reza Aslan, a professor of creative writing, is someone who is qualified to mediate the dialogue.
