Submission: your school must enter (a production of) your play as a Participating Entry by NOVEMBER 30

X John Cauble Short Play Award

- student-written
- short play

Submission: send to Jim Holmes (1ACTREG@GMAIL.COM) by OCTOBER 25

[Note: The John Cauble Award is connected to the one-act festival competition held at the regional and national levels.]

X Mark Twain Comedy Award

- student-written
- comic play or has some comic element to it

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by December 1

X Lorraine Hansberry Award

- student-written
- written by a person of African heritage
- deals with the African experience here or abroad

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by December 1

X Jean Kennedy Smith Award

- student-written
- deals with the human experience of living with a disability

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by December 1

X KC Youth and Families Playwriting Award

- student-written
- written on a theme that will appeal to young people, K-12th grades

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by December 1

X Paula Vogel Award

- student-written
- celebrates diversity and encourages tolerance while exploring issues of disempowered voices not traditionally considered mainstream

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by <u>December 1</u>

X Latino/a Playwriting Award

- student-written
- written by a person of Latino/a heritage

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by December 1

KCACTF National Science Playwriting Award (given every other year)

- student-written
- treats an assigned theme recognizing that science and scientists are a part of culture *Submission*: send to your regional chair and to the KC by <u>December 1</u>

X Quest for Peace Award

- student-written
- illuminates the complicated issues facing the Middle East, particularly Palestine and Israel

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by <u>December 1</u>

KCACTF Musical Theatre Award (composer, lyricist, and librettist are eligible)

- student- and/or faculty-written
- a musical

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by <u>December 1</u>

X Rosa Parks Playwriting Award

- student- or faculty-written
- addresses issues of social justice and/or civil rights

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by December 1

X Paul Stephen Lim Asian-American Playwriting Award

- student-written
- written by an Asian-American student; any subject matter

Submission: send to your regional chair and to the KC by December 1

X David Mark Cohen Award

- student-written or written by a working playwright (inc. faculty)
- produced at a college or university
- entered as an Associate or Participating Entry

Submission: send to the Region VIII chair by <u>NOVEMBER 1</u> (the chair, in turn, sends two nominations to the KC in late November)

Ken Ludwig Playwriting Scholarship

- Awarded for a student-written body of work
- Scholarship may not be deferred
