Acting Internships / LEVEL I

Learn what it takes to be part of a professional classical theatre company, performing three productions in rotating repertory! Acting Interns are challenged to apply their talents in all areas, from analyzing a classic text to running lights and sound.

TUITION: \$550.00

A limited number of scholarships are available.

Each acting intern is cast in a supporting role in

one or more plays in the repertory season. Interns may also be given understudy assignments.

TRAINING

Interns are immersed in 120+ hours of training designed to develop the whole artist. Course topics include: acting Shakespeare, speech, textual analysis & scansion, a scene study course that culminates in a workshop presentation for an invited audience.

TECHNICAL ASSIGNMENTS

Interns gain hands-on experience in one technical department (stage management, props, costumes, sets, lights, sound) and are a part of the changeover crew that facilitates the repertory schedule.

SCHEDULE

Interns must be available for classes, rehearsals, performances and technical calls during the following hours: Monday-Fridays 6-11pm and Saturday/Sundays (Day/Evening—depending on rep schedule and intern assignment). Additionally, interns must be available to perform a limited number of mid-week matinees as scheduled.

ADMISSION

To request an audition appointment, please fill out the attached form and mail along with photo and resume. Auditions are two contrasting monologues, one of which must be Shakespeare, not to exceed three minutes total.



Acting Internships / LEVEL II

Upon successful completion of the Level I Internship, a limited number of Acting Interns may be invited to join the Level II Internship for continued training.

Production Internships

Each Production Intern gains experience in his or her specific field of interest through one-on-one partnerships with the outstanding directors, designers and creative artists working in the company. Production Internships are available in the following areas: costume design, directing, dramaturgy, lighting design, props, set design, sound, stage management, theatre administration. Production Interns are also a part of the changeover crew that facilitates the repertory schedule.

Admission is by interview and portfolio review. To request an interview, please fill out the attached form and mail it along with a resume to A Noise Within.


