Your Spring 2008 course reports are enclosed. Please use this envelope to return the course reports to your department office once you have assigned your grades.

Please note that the Registrar's Office, in consultation with College Deans, Associate Deans, and Chairs, has been working to transition the campus to a single process for grade submission. Hence, effective Fall 2008, iGrade will be the only method for grade submission. In preparation for this transition, you can still opt-in to iGrade and utilize it for spring grade submission even though you are receiving your Spring 2008 roster in paper form.

Processing of your paper rosters is a multi-step process; therefore, please submit your rosters as your finals are completed. The Registrar's Office can post student grades in a timely manner if grades are submitted once finals are complete. If rosters are <u>not</u> submitted and processed by the final grade load, grades will be marked with a GD for "Grade Delay." This notation prompts students many times to contact their faculty member directly and also disrupts the advising, financial aid disbursement, transcript requests, and other administrative aspects of the student's university experience.

The FINAL deadline for submission of paper course reports to the Registrar's Office is *Tuesday*, *June 17, 2008, at 11:00 a.m.*

1100 Hinderaker Hall will be open during the following late hours for submission of grades through our mail slot. Please provide your department with a copy of your grades should you choose to submit them after normal business hours.
