Last Fall we met at Loyola Marymount to hear two papers. In the morning Brian Rutishauser presented a paper on "Convenient Neutrality: Parallel Trajectories of Corcyra and the Archaic Cyclades." Darel Engen from CSU San Marcos was the commentator. Following lunch, Tim Watson from UCI presented "Echoes of Corruption: Symmachus and the Defense of the Roman Senate" with a commentary by Tom Sizgorich of UCI.

This Spring we will again meet jointly with Penates, the Late Antique Group from Southern California, this time at UC Riverside, where Michele Salzman is our genial host and the History Department is supporting the costs of the meeting. From 10:00-10:30 coffee and rolls will be available, provided by the History Department at UCR. At 10:30, Tim Greene of Chaffey College will present "You All Know How Feeble The Roman Soldiers Are..." a paper exploring the Battle of Chalons, the decline of Roman forces in the West, and the influence of the Huns on Roman military thinking. Steve Chryssanthos of UC Riverside will be the commentator. After lunch, Brice Erickson of UC Santa Barbara will present "On the Edge of the Argolid Plain: Archaeology and History at Lerna, A Geometric-Hellenistic Village in Central Greece." Paul Scotton of CSU Long Beach will be the commentator.
