**POSITION:** The Department of English invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor with emphases in secondary education and TESOL. The ideal candidate would combine secondary education teaching experience with training in ESL, TESOL, and/or applied linguistics. In addition to teaching, research, and service obligations, duties may include advising and outreach activities associated with the state-certified Single Subject Matter Preparation Program. Effective teaching is a priority; scholarly productivity and service to the university are also required for retention, promotion, and tenure. This position is contingent upon the availability of authorized funding.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** A Ph. D. in English, English Education, TESOL, or related field is required. Other minimum qualifications include demonstrated successful teaching at the secondary level.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:** A candidate's consideration will be enhanced by providing evidence of expertise in TESOL and Second Language Acquisition, relevant research and publication, and a minimum of three years secondary school teaching experience. As part of a "Hispanic-Serving Institution," the department is especially interested in candidates with experience teaching and mentoring a diverse student population.

**HOW TO APPLY AND DEADLINE:** A complete application must include: an application letter specifically addressing the position description and qualifications; curriculum vitae; three recent letters of reference; evidence of teaching effectiveness (student and/or peer evaluation, performance reviews, etc.); and unofficial photocopies of graduate transcripts. A writing sample may be requested after initial screening. Official transcripts will be required at the time of hire.

Screening of completed application files will begin on March 4, 2011. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. The position will remain open until filled. The appointment begins on August 17, 2011.
