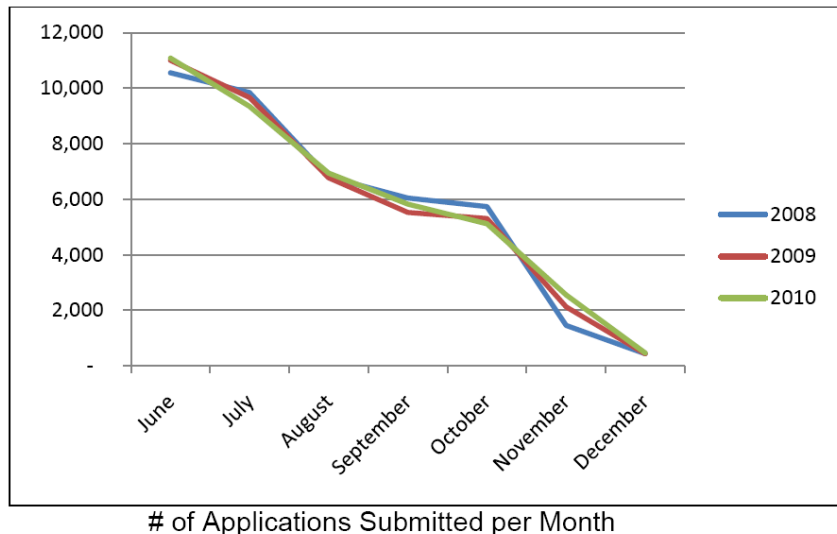


ATTENTION 2011 APPLICANTS to MD Programs

There are a few changes made to the application including a reduction of space provided for the description of some activities. It is important that you familiarize yourself with the application which will be accessible on **May 5** and can be submitted as early as **June 1**.

Please note that you are **encouraged not to be late in the submission of your application**. The chart below indicates the national trends for when the majority of applications for medical school are submitted.

Almost 50% of all applications are submitted in the months of June and July.
