Student Conduct Ready Advisor Program

- ✓ Students, Staff and Faculty are invited to participate
- ✓ Students going through the student conduct process have the right to have an advisor with him/her
- ✓ Students often would like to have an advisor but don't know who or how to ask.
- ✓ An advisor can be anyone of the student's choosing, not directly involved in the alleged incident.
- ✓ Advisors more familiar with the student conduct and academic integrity processes better serve the students and the UCR campus community.
- ✓ Time commitment for serving as advisor varies depending on the complexities of a case.
- ✓ To serve as part of the Student Conduct Ready Advisor Program, individuals are asked to participate in a training orientation session consisting of an overview of the student conduct and academic integrity processes, and resources available to students.
