Dr. Weber will speak about her work to establish the first-in-the-nation statewide Reparations Task Force (CA-AB3121) to study the consequences of slavery and systemic racism against African Americans in California, and to develop reparations proposals. As the task force completes the first of a two-year process, Weber will address challenges and next steps for reparations in California.



DR. SHIRLEY WEBER CALIFORNIA SECRETARY OF STATE

Dr. Shirley N. Weber is the first African American to serve as California's Secretary of State. Prior to this, she served four terms in the State Assembly (D-San Diego), and from 2019-20 was Chair of the California Legislative Black Caucus (CLBC). She received her BA, MA, and PhD from UCLA—all by the age of 26—and for 40 years was a professor of Africana Studies at San Diego State University. She authored California Assembly Bill 3121, signed into law in 2020.
