STAFF AND FACULTY DIVERSITY CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

The eight-month Making Excellence Inclusive Diversity Certificate Program will guide participants through a series of learning activities designed to emphasize the commitment to equity and inclusion as a core value in an increasingly diverse campus environment.

The program is developed around the belief that individuals learn most effectively when they discover, understand, and apply their new knowledge to the real world situations they face in the university environment.

PROGRAM ELEMENTS

INTERACTIVE DISCUSSION SESSIONS

Engaging and sustaining discussion sessions for participants to strengthen understanding and collaborate on various DEI topics.

WORKSHOPS

Representing a broad range of diversity topics led by guest speakers and professionals.

CAPSTONE PROJECT & Presentations

Participants will create practical application of the concepts, and will develop an innovative project or policy recommendation that will improve staff engagement and workplace culture at UCR with an inclusive climate in mind.



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ELIGIBILITY

This course is delivered over an eight-month period. The course meets every third Thursday (Oct. - May) from 1 pm - 5 pm. Sessions will be held virtually on Zoom for the 2022-2023 cohort.

Completed their employee probationary period at UCR

• Endorsement for participation from their department/supervisor

*Only one excused absence is allotted during the 8-month course in order to earn the certification.
