WHAT IS SWIFT?

- Student Well-being, Intervention, and Follow-up Team (SWIFT) is a newly created department in the Division of Health, Well-being, & Safety (HWS) that provides mental health crisis response and intervention.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Master's or Doctorate in clinical/counseling psychology or other behavioral health discipline
- Current, valid license in the State of California (Psychologist, LMFT, LCSW, etc.)
- 8 - 13 years of related experience
- ***Preferred:** 5 years of leadership and management experience in a mental health orgz.

ROLE OF THE SWIFT DIRECTOR

- Oversees the response to students in crisis after hours, and connecting them to support and resources.
*** Expectation of availability after hours to serve the occasional urgent needs of students and campus crisis.***
- Leads the SWIFT department by providing strategic vision and creative leadership.
- Managing the departmental operating budget.
- Direct clinical services in support of the SWIFT department scope of services to maintain clinical licensure, etc.
- Works with all eight other HWS departments, notably: the UCR Police Department, Campus Advocacy, Resources & Education (CARE), Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS), and Case Management (CM).
