

Dr. Alberto Búrquez works at the Department of Ecology of Biodiversity, University of Mexico (UNAM). He got his PhD at the University of Cambridge, UK. He does research in Ecology, Evolutionary Biology, and Ethnoecology in the Sonoran Desert, Baja California, and the American Southwest. Born in the Sonoran Desert, dryland ecology and societal use of resources in water-limited systems have been his central research interest. A prolific author, he has published two books on columnar cacti with the University of Arizona Press, Tucson. His current projects include: (1) Columnar cacti: ecology, evolution, societal services, (2) effects of extreme events on vegetation, (3) species distribution and biogeography, (4) Indigenous lands and ecosystem processes, and (5) drought and freezing resistance in plants at the edges of their distribution.
