**Biosketch:**

David Haviland is the Entomology and Pest Management Advisor for the UC Cooperative Extension office in Kern County. For more than 20 years he has conducted research and extension programs on arthropod pests of almonds, pistachios, grapes, stone fruit, citrus and blueberries the lower San Joaquin Valley. His expertise is in integrated pest management and he has published on monitoring, treatment thresholds, predator-prey relationships, augmentative biological control, mating disruption and chemical control. He has given more than 700 extension presentations, written more than 400 publications that primarily target growers, and been quoted in more than 300 articles by the popular press. He has received individual and team awards for extension from the UC Division of Agriculture and Natural Resources, Entomological Society of America, California Department of Pesticide Regulation, Western Extension Director's Association, Association of IPM Ecologists, and International IPM Symposium.
