

Junior Specialist Position in Bioinformatics

The Department of Entomology at the University of California invites applicants for a Junior Specialist position [full-time or part-time depending on level of experience] in bioinformatics to conduct applied research for the Hansen Lab in Riverside, CA. The purpose of this position is to assist with building and running bioinformatics pipelines for the Hansen laboratory. The final candidate will possess specialized skills in informatics such as coding in a diversity of computer languages and managing large amounts of data. The position also requires the ability to interpret and implement new bioinformatics projects and their analyses in collaboration with the PI and/or other Hansen lab members.

At the date of application, applicants should possess a baccalaureate degree (or equivalent degree) or equivalent research/job experience in the informatics field.

Preferred qualifications for this position include: experience in coding in multiple computer languages; prior experience working in bioinformatics or informatics; a baccalaureate degree in informatics or a related field.

Advancement through the Specialist position ranks at the University of California is through a series of structured, merit-based evaluations, occurring every 2-3 years, each of which includes substantial peer input.
