
1. Document and identify moths from field surveys

2. Measure moths using ImageJ program

- Lab or remote options
- Measure and record moth size data using photos and computer software
- Must be detail-oriented, experience with excel desired





3. Record, clean, and analyze plant-Lepidoptera interaction data

- Remote (computer-based data project)
- Record data from online resources, check previously entered data, analyze
- Experience with data management in excel and statistical software desired
