## OVERVIEW

The STOP COVID-19 Art Expression (e.g., drawings, poems, and videos) contest aims to engage the community in civic engagement via the arts to showcase how the Black Community has been adversely impacted by COVID-19 as well as demonstrate how we can overcome and move towards addressing concerns within the Black community.



## JUDGING CRITERIA

- Does the art expression show the adverse effects of COVID-19 on the Black Community (e.g., how past medical abuses influence experiences related to COVID-19 vaccination, and/or how economic and social stability has declined in the current pandemic).
- Does the art expression show people with dignity, equality, support, and integrity?
- Does the art expression offer a practical/pragmatic solution?

## GUIDELINES

To be considered for this award, each entry must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Submit art expression to [CHC@medsch.ucr.edu](mailto:CHC@medsch.ucr.edu)
- Art expression can be submitted by individuals or by a group e.g., individuals 18+
- The top art expression will be chosen based on the judging criteria above.

## AWARDS AND PRIZES

- 1st place: \$400
- 2nd place: \$300
- 3rd place: \$200
- 4th place: \$100
