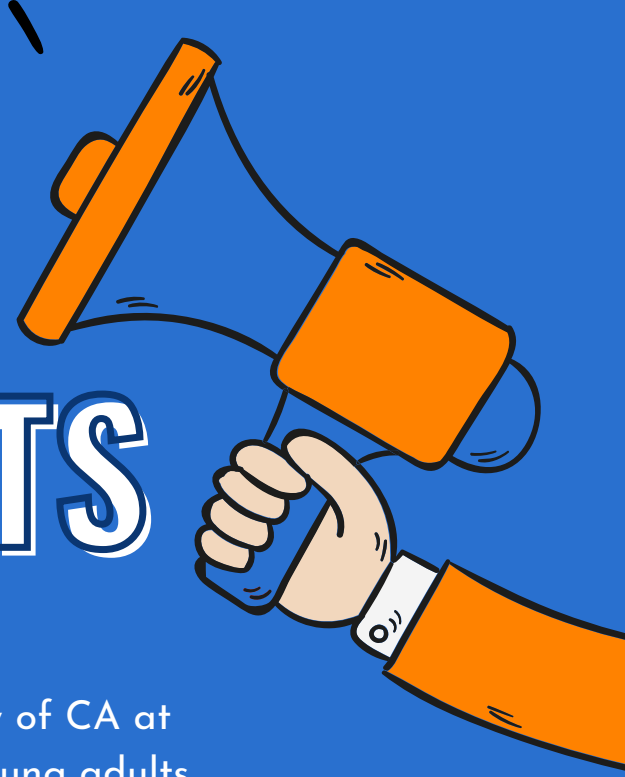


# SEEKING PARTICIPANTS
