LABORATORY HAZARD ASSESSMENT TOOL (LHAT)

The Laboratory Hazard Assessment Tool (LHAT) has been created as part of the University of California's commitment to continuing a culture of safety. LHAT is a web-based system intended to identify and communicate hazards present in a laboratory or research area. Once the hazards are identified, laboratory personnel can take appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) training and print a voucher that can be exchanged for free PPE. LHAT will be used by all academic appointees, staff, students, and visitors to prevent workplace illnesses and injuries.

Principal Investigator (PI) or Laboratory/Shop Supervisor

As a PI or Laboratory/Shop Supervisor, LHAT allows you to:

- Create a laboratory roster
- Determine hazards that are present in the laboratory
- Identify, assess and certify laboratory hazards and locations
- Communicate laboratory hazards with laboratory personnel
- Identify the proper PPE to be used based on the hazard assessment



Laboratory Personnel


As a laboratory personnel, LHAT allows you to:

- Identify with a lab group
- Review and acknowledge laboratory hazard assessment
- Receive a list of proper PPE to be used in your laboratory setting
- Complete PPE training and receive a voucher for free PPE to be redeemed at EH&S.

How to Create, Amend or Re-certify Your LHAT


New PI/Supervisor:

Assessment"




PI/Supervisor To Amend/Re-Certify:
