
LHAT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND PPE

When joining a laboratory, your supervisor should add you to the Laboratory Hazard Assessment Tool (LHAT) for your lab. An LHAT informs you about the hazards you might encounter while working, and what Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) you should wear in the lab. Acknowledging the LHAT and following the PPE guidance is an important part of staying safe in a research lab.

Acknowledging an LHAT

1- When you are added to the LHAT, you'll get an email to acknowledge the Assessment. To see an LHAT you are already on, go to ehs.ucop.edu and review the Workspace section.


2- Review the PPE and hazard info, then click "Acknowledge" on the right hand column to acknowledge the LHAT. After acknowledging you will go to "Next Steps" for PPE.



- · Review the information about hazards present in the laboratory
- Review the identified Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) required for this laboratory
- Acknowledge that you have read the laboratory hazard assessment
- Complete any training required to work in the laboratory
