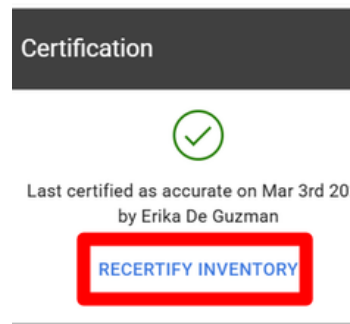
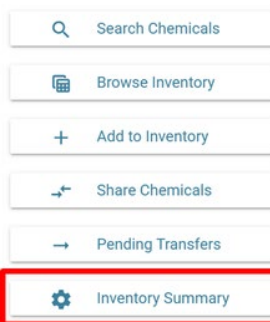
Chemical Inventory Certification

All chemical inventory owners are required to certify their online inventory every 12 months. This supports the safety of not only those in labs, but also emergency responders during incidents. Here is a how to and some tips for getting the most out of the online system.

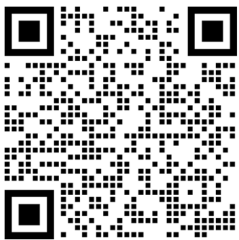
How-To: Certify Online Chemical Inventory



1. Log into [RSS Chemicals](#)
2. Review inventory and update as needed
3. Click on "Inventory Summary"
4. Click on "Certify Inventory" and a pop-up will appear
5. Click on "Certify"



Tip #1: Use the RSS Chemicals Mobile App

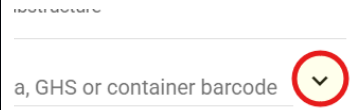
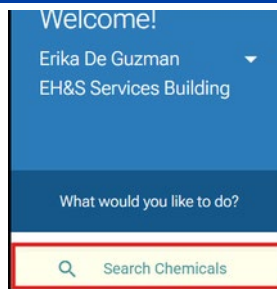


The RSS Chemicals app makes it more convenient to find chemical information on the go. Use it to scan RSS barcodes to quickly find chemical hazard and storage information. It can also be used to add and remove chemicals from the inventory.

Once you have added all materials in the lab to your inventory, the Principal Investigator/ Supervisor or delegate can certify the inventory.

Tip #2: Use Advanced Search

Need a refresher on which chemicals are suspected of causing cancer, reproductive harm, or other adverse health affects? Use advanced search on the RSS Chemicals web version to search your inventory for these and other hazard classifications.
