I'm excited to tell you about our **MA program in English**, a flexible program offering students the chance to forge their own degree paths while selecting from a variety of English and interdisciplinary coursework, benefiting from professional mentoring, and pursuing internship opportunities. Highlights include:

- Funding packages for most accepted students, which include competitive teaching assistantships and research assistantships (tuition and fee waiver, plus a stipend of ~\$17,000), scholarships, work opportunities, and financial aid packages.
- World-renowned faculty in the fields of environmental humanities, narratology, affect theory, rhetorical theory, applied linguistics, and nineteenth- and twentieth-century Anglophone literatures, as well as access to award-winning creative writers.
- The opportunity to **study and research in all areas of English and cultural studies** and to pursue **interdisciplinary coursework** in Women's, Gender & Sexuality Studies; Natural Resources and Environmental Science; Foreign Languages; and Film & Television Studies.
- Editorial internships at our in-house, nationally ranked literary magazine FUGUE.
- Internships with the <u>Confluence Lab</u>, an interdisciplinary research lab with scholars from the humanities, arts, social sciences, and biophysical sciences addressing environmental problems.
- Up to two years of classroom teaching experience and training in composition pedagogy.
- **Programmatic mentorship and professionalization workshops** for students entering doctoral programs, the academic job market, and a wide array of public and private industries, as well as training for all teaching assistants.
- Generous travel support for students attending regional, national, and international conferences.
- An annual graduate student conference, organized by second-year MA students with faculty mentorship.

Located in Moscow, ID—a warm and welcoming community consistently rated among the <u>best college</u> towns and <u>best places to raise a family</u> in the U.S.—the University of Idaho is nestled among the gorgeous Palouse Hills, with ample opportunities for outdoor recreation.
