This will be accomplished by managing pest lures on designated raspberry/blackberry ranches as well as logging findings, auditing grower practices through risk assessment evaluations, retrieving and reviewing spray records with entomologist and working closely with Quality Assurance to investigate all SWD incidences and holding test results. The position will also support special projects and crop monitoring as needed.
