

Plant Mite Bioinvasions as a Long-Standing But Raising Challenge to Agriculture

Crop protection confronts several defies often related to globalization. Bioinvasions or the introduction of new pests from one region or from one continent to another is one of the key challenges agriculture faces that might also be exacerbated by environmental modifications linked to climate change. In this talk, we will focus on invasive mites, mainly in Latin America and in Europe. Taking case studies as examples, we question the lessons taken from the past and foresee mite pest invasions.
