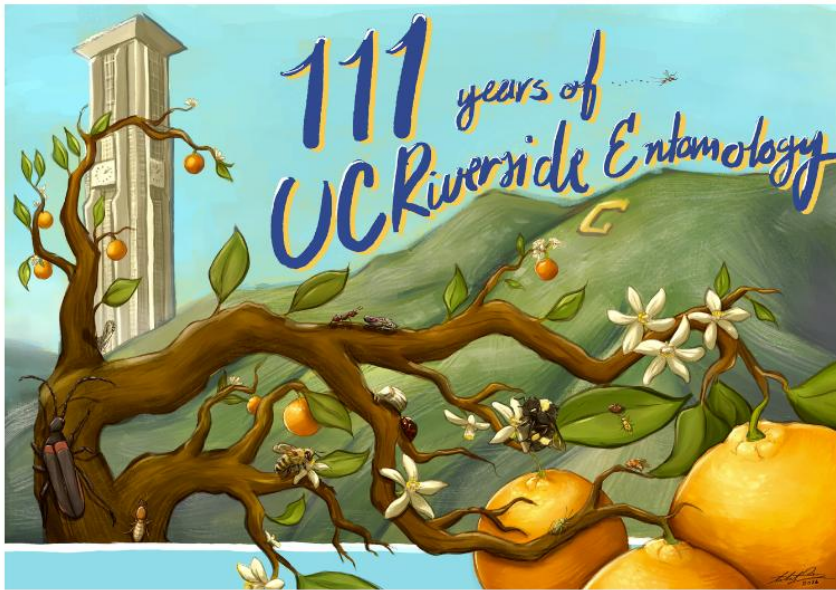
Help!
