**Abstract:**

Dr. Uyi’s research program is focused on elucidating the ecology of insect-plant interactions and management of invasive pest species in horticultural and agricultural ecosystems. Using examples from multiple model systems on two different continents, he will demonstrate how knowledge of insect-plant interactions, thermal biology and nutritional ecology contribute to advances in pest management using biological, cultural, and insecticidal control approaches.
