We are a team of scientists

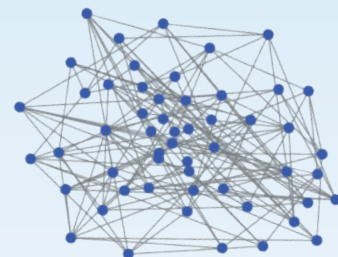
studying the evolution of gene function, gene regulatory networks and chromatin in our zoo of emerging model organisms.
