

Visiting Lecturer Position in Ethnomusicology at Pomona College for Fall 2022

Pomona College is seeking a lecturer to fill a one-semester visiting position in Ethnomusicology in the Music Department for Fall 2022 (late August – December). Candidates should hold the Ph.D. or ABD and show evidence of ethnomusicological research as indicated by scholarly presentations or publications. Preference will be given to candidates with at least two years' relevant teaching experience. The candidate should be committed to working in an undergraduate liberal arts environment. The teaching load consists of two undergraduate courses: "Introduction to World Music" and "Ethnomusicology in Theory, Method, and Practice." The successful candidate will have experience working with students from diverse backgrounds and a demonstrated commitment to improving higher education for underrepresented students.

We will begin considering applications as of April 15, 2022, and will continue the search process until the position has been filled. This is a restricted local search, and the position is not eligible for visa sponsorship.
