WHEREAS the Graduate Student Association of the University of California, Riverside (GSAUCR) acknowledges that April is Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM); and

WHEREAS graduate and professional students fall victims to sexual assault violence; and

WHEREAS the GSAUCR has failed to provide any programs, workshops, support on Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM) at the University of California, Riverside; and

WHEREAS the graduate and professional students at UCR are also victims/survivorss of forms of sexual violence; and

WHEREAS the GSAUCR has failed to address Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM) within the broader community UCR; and

WHEREAS it is the right of all graduate and professional students under UCOP policy to exercise their constitutional right to free speech in support of those causes in which they believe; now therefore, let it be

RESOLVED that the GSAUCR will hold a seminar in April of 2021. The seminar will center issues of sexual assault and other forms of sexual violence, particularly the impacts on our fellow graduate peers in academia. The purpose of the seminar will be to educate the community of graduate and professional students at UCR on understanding how sexual assault, and other forms of sexual violence prevail in our institutions. Also how to provide support and resources to victims any form of sexual assault, whether they be colleagues or students we interact with through our roles as Teaching Assistants, mentors, and educators. The seminar will also help graduate and professional students understand how to serve as an accomplice to those who may disclose experiences of sexual violence while adhering to their roles as mandated reporters;

RESOLVED that the GSAUCR will reallocate funds from the following line items to cover the cost of the seminar: WELL Budget \$ 300.
