Award Event

Criteria

- Cumulative GPA of 3.500 or higher as of Fall 2023
- Current SOE student in PhD, MA, or MEd program, excluding General Education MEd and Special Education MEd with credential
- Enrolled Spring 2024 for the award to disburse

Essay prompt

PhD applicants are required to submit an essay highlighting their commitment to the [SOE's equity-focused mission](#), and how this aligns with their professional engagement activities, including (but not limited to): conference presentations, peer-reviewed publications, awards and community engagement activities.

MA/MEd applicants should describe their commitment to the [SOE's equity-focused mission](#), and how this aligns with their professional and community engagement activities, while highlighting specific barriers they may have encountered and overcame.

Essays should be 1-2 pages double-spaced in APA format and submitted as a PDF.

Applicants are allowed to apply for more than one scholarship in a single application. Additional selection criteria (if applicable) are listed below.

PhD students

1. Harry Singer Endowed Fellowship Fund (\$1,850)
 - PhD student in the area of curriculum and instruction with special interest in the field of reading and literacy
 - Must submit research paper or project to support specified interests

2. Robert C. Calfee & Nel Little Calfee Endowed Doctoral Student Fellowship (\$1,700)
 - Fee support award for student in PhD program
 - Passed the oral qualifying exam
3. Flora Ida Ortiz Endowed Fellowship Fund (\$4,400)
 - Fee support for PhD students whose interests include the study of women in educational administration, Latina superintendents, and Latino student achievement
 - Female and minority students seeking administrative positions in education are also eligible
 - Must submit research paper or project to support specified interests
4. Richard R. Kokes Endowed Fellowship Fund (\$5,800)
 - Enrolled in PhD program
5. Robin J. McKeown Memorial Fellowship (\$900)
 - Must have accepted paper/presentation at AERA 2024 conference
 - Submit copy of accepted paper/presentation and proof of acceptance
