In this program, high school juniors take a practice Analytical Writing Placement Exam, which the University of California has been using for entering freshmen since 1987. The practice exams are assessed analytically by University of California professionals who teach college-level composition courses. The evaluation aims at helping each individual student understand college expectations for reading/writing competence and to help them improve through personalized feedback on their writing and through access to a video presentation that provides them with information and strategies for meeting college-level expectations for academic reading and writing.
