
## Faculty Recruitment Assistant or Associate Professor

We are particularly interested in candidates whose research focuses on the mechanistic aspects of cancer initiation or progression or the development of target-specific inhibitors that can reverse pathogenic symptoms. In addition to overseeing their own independent research group, the new recruit will have an opportunity to participate in the educational mission of the Department and the Keck School of Medicine by teaching and training MS, PhD, and medical students (https://keck.usc.edu/education/).

The research space for this recruitment will be within the Keck School of Medicine at the Health Sciences Campus of USC. Significant resources are available to support research throughout the medical campus, including core facilities available in the USC/Norris Comprehensive Cancer Center, the Zilkha Neurogenetic Institute, the Broad Center for Regenerative Medicine and Stem Cell Research, and the Institute of Translational Genomics.

The position requires a Ph.D. or M.D. and relevant postdoctoral experience. Faculty rank will be determined by the qualifications of the successful candidate. The salary will be commensurate with experience and the successful candidate will be provided with a competitive startup package.
