Seminar Title: "Non-Canonical RNA Binding in Normal and Cancer Biology"

**Abstract:** The Dominguez Lab focuses on understanding RNA binding mechanisms and their downstream regulatory consequences. This seminar will highlight the complex ways in which individual RNA-binding proteins (RBPs) interact with RNA through both intrinsically disordered and well-structured domains. Additionally, it will present insights into how cancerassociated mutations affect RBP-RNA interactions and phenotypes, from biochemical characterization to animal models.
