-A one page artist statement outlining who you are, why you make art, and what your goals are as an artist.

-A one page resume listing relevant coursework, performances, compositions, collaborations, etc.

-(Optional) A .pdf with links to music, videos, concerts, mixes, etc. with descriptions of your role for each.

-A video of yourself answering the following questions (cell phone video is ok):

- 1) Why do you want to join UCR's Music Industry Track?
- 2) How will you be an addition to the UCR community?
