RACE, CLASS, AND THE POLITICS OF SITUATIONAL TRUST

Ph.D. Candidate Justin Zimmerman will share insights from his research on how residents of race-class subjugated communities advocate for themselves against state and community violence in Chicago. Justin argues that communities low in resources and collective efficacy will engage in situational trust to promote and implement policies to remedy violence. After conducting semi-structured interviews and attending community events in a predominately Black community on the South Side of Chicago, Justin found that residents of the Greater Englewood area engage in situational trust with police, outside organizations, and local politicians in the hopes of remedying state and community violence.
