The EMW is an annual invitation-only day-long workshop that occurs in tandem with the <u>Institute for Qualitative and Multi-Method Research</u> (IQMR) at Syracuse University. The next EMW takes place on **June 22**, **2025**. The EMW is supported by generous funding from the National Science Foundation.

At each EMW, six scholars present and receive feedback on a paper they wrote and circulated in advance. Presenters receive intensive mentoring and join and build scholarly networks. The goal of the EMW is to increase the diversity of the community of scholars who develop, teach, and write about qualitative research methods and the conduct of multi-method research.
