The updates discussed below are now in effect as of July 1.

Hello UCR Grad Students-

I hope your spring quarter is going well! I'm writing with some very important information about an update to the procedures in Graduate Division.

Starting July 1st, 2025 all deadlines will be strictly enforced. Deadlines can be found [HERE](#).

Here's what that means in practice:

- If a petition arrives in the "Graduate Dean" queue in [R'Grad](#) after the posted deadline, it will be denied. That means all petitions should be initiated well before the deadline for them to fully route to us in time.
- Please check with your [program](#), as they may have internal deadlines several weeks earlier than the posted Graduate Division deadlines to ensure that your petitions are successfully processed.
- It's your responsibility to ensure that the petition reaches Graduate Division in time. Remember that you can check on the status of petitions in R'Grad to ensure that they keep moving forward.
