Reel Medicine: Expanding the Framework of Indigenized Television

Indigenous artists share their insights in advance of (or in response to) a variety of social, political, and cultural developments. Case in point, filmmakers Sterlin Harjo and Taika Waititi reimagine Indigenous communities via intentional media projects. Their most recent collaborative venture, *Reservation Dogs*, is a landmark television series that transcends borders and boundaries, deconstructs binary notions of identity, and promotes inherent tribal sovereignty. This presentation will discuss ways in which *Reservation Dogs* increases visibility of contemporary Indigenous realities and revises public perceptions of Indigenous communities.
