## Reel Medicine: Expanding the Framework of Indigenized Television

Indigenous artists share their insights in advance of (or in response to) a variety of social, political, and cultural developments. Their most recent collaborative venture, Reservation Dogs, is a landmark television series that transcends borders and boundaries, deconstructs binary notions of identity, and promotes inherent tribal sovereignty.
