- ◆ ELEVATE is a PhD fellowship program that trains students to solve technical and equity challenges in the energy transition.
- ◆ The program includes a game-based course, training in **leadership and public engagement**, and connections to jobs in academia, government, non-profits, and the private sector.
- ◆ Students conduct **interdisciplinary** research through collaboration with other students, faculty, and community members.
- ◆ **High impact!** ELEVATE solutions and innovations are implemented in local and international communities.
- ◆ ELEVATE is committed to fostering an **inclusive** and welcoming environment.



Compensation

- ◆ Students receive 1-2 years of fellowship funding through ELEVATE and are nominated for up to 2 additional years of fellowship funding through UMass.
- ◆ Fellows receive yearly travel funding, health insurance, and tuition and fee waivers.
