

## AED REQUIREMENTS

- A Certificate of Medical Oversight is placed next to the AED unit.

Current expiration of Certificate of Medical Oversight is March 1, 2027.

- Monthly Monitoring through a third- party documentation.

We use AED Total solutions-Shondra Scott monitors them, Hernan Salazar is back-up.

## AED California State requirements:

- AED Registration is required.

Julian Corral (Occupational Health Coordinator EH&S) confirmed that all four units are registered.

- AEDs should be maintained according to the manufacturer's specifications and tested at least biannually and after use.
- When an AED is placed in a building, the building manager shall, at least once a year, notify the tenants as to the location of the AED units and provide information to tenants about who they can contact if they want to take AED or CPR training.
- Instructions for AED use should be posted in 14-point type next to the device.

## AED Cabinet

- AED Cabinets have an internal alarm system, this is to alert staff to respond to the area. There is a shunt key to turn off the alarm. Keys: Hernan has one key, Floor 1 and 2 have keys in the fire extinguisher cases in lobby, Nikki McAndrew has two keys.
