## **Speaker Biography**



Dr. Jodie S. Holt has been the Director of the UC Riverside Botanic Gardens since 2016, a position she began after retiring from 30+ years as Professor of Plant Physiology at UCR. She received her B.S.

degree in Botany from the University of Georgia and her M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Botany from the University of California, Davis. During her career at UCR she also served as Chair of the Department of Botany & Plant Sciences and Divisional Dean of Agriculture & Natural Resources. Her research program at UCR focused on ecology and management of invasive exotic weeds in wildlands and agriculture, and she published numerous articles, chapters, and books on this subject. Jodie taught graduate and undergraduate courses at UCR, including 20+ years teaching her favorite subject, botany, and in 2008 won the UCR Distinguished Teaching Award. In 2010 the San Diego Botanical Garden awarded her the Paul Ecke, Jr. Award of Excellence for her work promoting plants and conservation. In her spare time she has dabbled in botanical consulting, most notably for the movie Avatar and related products.
