ABOUT BEYOND BRILLIANT

Beyond Brilliant is UC Riverside’s first fundraising initiative dedicated to student-focused priorities across the university. With your help, UC Riverside will raise \$50 million over the next five years to build resources that support every aspect of the student experience at UCR, including expanding need- and merit-based scholarships and fellowships, experiential learning, and health and well-being. And we’ll create additional opportunities and programs for Highlanders to shine brightly in their academic pursuits, personal lives, and professional ambitions — all with the care of a community committed to their lifelong success. PRIMARY MESSAGE

At UC Riverside, we actively create a campus culture that achieves excellence and champions inclusion. For three consecutive years, U.S. News and World Report ranked UCR the number one university in the country for social mobility, and our six-year graduation rates far exceed the national standard. More than 133,000 Highlander alumni, along with thousands of donors and advocates, have helped us get where we are today. But at UCR, our attention lies beyond where we are now and what’s been done before. Our focus is a brighter tomorrow.

Message:

What's better than rubbing shoulders with Nobel Prize winners? Sharing ideas with them. And at UCR, that's exactly what students are able to do. After all, we have two of them on our faculty along with 13 members of the National Academies of Science and Medicine. With a proud history of more than 60 years of high-impact research, UCR provides a rigorous and future-focused environment that prepares students to take on the world through real-life applications. Our top programs span from undergraduate hands-on research in state-of-the-art labs to the nation's first Ph.D. in dance to a department of Entomology ranked No. 2 in the world. At UCR, students are exposed to a wide variety of viewpoints and methods, all within a tremendously collaborative community. Our setting, renowned faculty, and rigorous courses produce leading professionals who are prepared to tackle the dynamic challenges that face not only California's fastest-growing region, but the world at large.

Power Claims:

- UCR's distinguished faculty boasts 2 Nobel Laureates, and 13 members of the National Academies of Science and Medicine.
- UCR's Creat'R Lab provides tools, technologies, and equipment for student-led innovations and collaborations. In its first year of operation the makerspace hosted nearly 1,300 creators, 187 workshops led by student organizations, and entrepreneurs-in-residence to mentor students.
- \$1 billion in construction will be completed or underway by 2021.
- Home to the largest indoor atmospheric test chamber, UCR is a national leader in air pollution and alternative fuels research.
- Ranked No. 2 in the world, UCR's Department of Entomology maintains one of the nation's largest collections of insect specimens. – Center for World University Rankings.
- UCR ARTS in downtown Riverside is home to the Barbara and Art Culver Center of the Arts and the California Museum of Photography, the largest photographic center in the Western U.S.
- The new Multidisciplinary Research Building supports cutting-edge research at the intersection of life and chemical sciences, medicine, engineering, and computation to advance health and science.

Message:

At UCR we bring together high academic standards with a highly supportive, inclusive environment; one in which we embolden exceptional students who go on to prosper individually and positively impact their communities. We take pride in cultivating individuals who are personally fulfilled and socially connected.

UCR is committed to enriching the economic, social, and cultural future of our students. Our student population mirrors the state of California, creating one of the most diverse and inclusive research institutions within the prestigious University of California system..

Power Claims:

- With over 450 options, UCR has a vibrant community of student organizations, including cultural clubs, student government, as well as recreational, political, and service-based groups.
- The Well, a stand-alone, non-clinical health promotion center for students, opened more than a decade ago. Annually it provides nearly 12,000 students with resources for promoting wellness, including sexual health products and peer-to-peer support programs.
- The campus food pantry, R'Pantry, provides emergency food, personal hygiene, household care and childcare items for students experiencing food insecurity. During the first six weeks of the campus closure due to the COVID-19 pandemic, R'Pantry served more than 1,200 students.
- A leader in diversity and inclusion, UC Riverside was the first campus in the nation to offer a gender-neutral housing option (2005), as well as the first campus in California to open a professionally-staffed LGBT resource office (1993) and offer an LGBT studies minor (1996). Named one of the 11 Best Colleges for Queer Women by PRIDE.COM (2019).

TITLE TREATMENT AS AN INITIATIVE MARK




The Beyond Brilliant mark represents the bright, energetic, diverse student body that makes up UCR. This feeling of movement and energy is key to use of the mark. The mark is a combination of **Fira Ultra Italic** and a layering of organic shapes colored in the UCR color palette. When using the pattern behind the letterforms, keep within the same color family, so that the mark will be more legible when placed on different color backgrounds. See examples above. Example 1 is reversed over an entirely blue pattern and example 2 is reserved over an entirely warm (orange and yellow) pattern.

The pattern behind the Beyond Brilliant mark does not need to be consistent from mark to mark. Slight variations in the way the shapes are expressed behind the letterforms will reinforce the movement and energy the mark is meant to convey.




When combining the mark and tagline, choose one of the colors from the pattern being used for the mark that will be most legible over the background image.


When using a multi-colored pattern as the background image, reverse both the BEYOND BRILLIANT mark and tagline out in white.

COLOR PALETTE



COLOR LAYERING

To build the background patterns, a variety of translucent settings (such as overlay, multiply or linear burn) can be used to add depth to the composition. When layering colors with such effects, be sure the resulting colors are still shades of blue, yellow, or orange.

Avoid using any translucent effects that result in the creation of other colors, such as green, brown or black.



PRIMARY TYPEFACE

The Beyond Brilliant primary typeface is Fira Ultra Italic. The heavy weight reveals a bold, fun, and approachable version of our brand, while the italics represents our future-fluent movement.

SECONDARY TYPEFACE

The Beyond Brilliant secondary typeface is Shockwave. The secondary typeface should not be used extensively. It is meant to add a sense of humanity and personalization.

Use the secondary typeface for quotes, inspirational messages, or to add personal story details about the subject of an image. Do not use the secondary typeface for any vital or informational text.




PHOTOGRAPHY GUIDELINES

The Beyond Brilliant initiative uses a very distinct photo style.

- **Student focused** — subject should have a natural and engaging demeanor. Subject can be interacting with personal items that represent themselves, but in a natural way.
- **Studio shots** — images must be taken on a yellow or blue backdrop, and include subtle yellow or blue (opposite the backdrop color) spot lights.
- **Shapes** — Images must include an organic layering of shapes interacting behind the subject. These shapes must feel animate and have slight variations from image to image, representing the layering of diversity that our student population provides.
